



The Toys for Tots program within our club is alive and healthy and we all thank Fred for his years of service and guidance along the way. Many of the workshops have already started making toys for this year's donations to the Marines and some of the new toys were displayed in the June meeting.

Joe has made a change within the committee and consolidated the materials acquisition to one person. Bob Andrews will continue to be the point of contact for the purchased items such as wheels, dowels, axle pins, etc and is now the single point of contact for the club for material from the Hardwood Store of NC. We want to thank Les Hall for his service over the past few years in this latter capacity. Bob and Joe have a meeting with the Hardwood Store in early July regarding material and that info will be shared as soon as possible.

With the relaxation of most/all of the restrictions during the pandemic, The Toys for Tots Committee is working to restore our December workshop at Klingspor's as well as a get-together in December to celebrate our club's successes, like we enjoyed prior to the pandemic. ## TOYS FOR TOTS KICK-OFF

The June meeting presentation was given by club members. Presenters included Joe Sabo, Jim Rhodes, Bob Gabor, Roy Brookhart, Bob Gabor and Alex Knittel. All presentations were video recorded and will be available on the TWA website.

Fred was unable attend due to a medical issue in his family. In his stead, Roy Brookhart provided the announcement that Fred had planned to make that he would be stepping down from his position as Toys for Tots chairperson. Fred has served the Toys for Tots program as the official chairperson since 2000 and the Toys for Tots program for 32 years. Fred will continue to support Toys for Tots and will remain as an active TWA member. In his place, Joe Sabo will be taking over the chair role for Toys for Tots.

In his first official role, Joe Sabo served as host for the meeting. He announced that the annual Klingspor's Toys for Tots workshop will occur on Saturday, December 3. Also, the December annual celebration meeting will be held on Tuesday, December 6th. The Toys for Tots committee is exploring meeting site location alternatives plus restarting some form of the dinner

format as was practiced pre-Covid. Joe requested workshop leaders respond to Bob Andrews to provide their needs for toy parts on the EXCEL spreadsheet he recently issued.

Joe Sabo showed new toy prototypes his workshop is developing this year. These new items include helicopters, several new car styles, and puzzles. Joe then provided insight on how he uses jigs to help increase toy production and quality. He showed and demonstrated the jigs his workshop uses to make toy trucks.

Joe Sabo indicated that Bob Andrews and Judy Sanwald's workshop will be adding a new spelling box containing letters to help youngsters with their spelling. They are also planning to make a new puzzle game.

Joe also showed the helicopter, trucks and cars that Pete Hodges and Fred Ford's workshop will be making this year.

Jim Rhodes will be making tractors this year. Jim showed the jigs he uses in making the tractors. Jim also

shared a picture of a nine-foot cross he made for his grandson's wedding.

Bob Gabor showed an art box that will be filled in art supplies. Bob previewed a new collapsible phone stand that his workshop will be making this year.

Roy Brookhart previewed Terry Tenhouse's workshop craft boxes and toy truck and cars projects planned for this year. Their workshop is also planning to make Connect 4 games this year.

Alex Knittel previewed a train engine and tender toy set he is planning for this year.

Bob Gabor indicated that he has two older projects, rocking chairs and Barbie beds, that he is no longer planning to make but has plans and jigs available to any workshops that would like them.
